

### Steinfest has been on the hunt for 75 years

BRILLION – It was rare during the peak of the Brillion Iron Works for R.D. Peters to give an extra day off, but for many years, workers received an extra Monday off during deer hunting.

That was perfect for Jim Steinfest, who by the time he started at the Brillion Iron Works in 1956, had already been hunting for years.

"Peters gave us Monday off because he was a hunter himself. We'd have off three days – Saturday, Sunday, Monday," Steinfest said. "It was great for a person like me who had no vacation coming."

Steinfest, who grew up in Brillion on the Steinfest Farms, first

started deer hunting when he was 14, so this year marked 75 years of him on the hunt each fall.

"I was 14 when I started. My brother was 17 and he'd gone up one year by my great uncle and most of the Steinfest relation is up around Antigo, and he had gone up the year before me," Steinfest said.

The next year Steinfest went up north to his uncle's farm with his brother. It hasn't stopped since.

"All 75 years that I've hunted were all up north," Steinfest said. He quickly fell in love with

hunting as a 14-year-old.

"That was just a great thing. I didn't have a decent gun; I had a Ford shotgun, and I couldn't shoot long-range with it. It was challenging," Steinfest recalls.

Eventually he was able to pur-

chase his own gun by the time he was 20.

Each year it's been a family tradition as throughout the years he's hunted with siblings, uncles, children and grandchildren.

"Today I own a place up at Armstrong Creek and we hunt up there in the Nicolet National Forest, and it's my son and two sons-in-law and one grandson who sometimes comes up for a day or two," Steinfest said.

The group processes all of their deer right in their cabin as they get them.

"We bring home frozen meat for sausage and what not," Steinfest said. "I think a favorite is the summer sausage or salami ... but we have wieners made, bologna meat."
