





Professional Plating celebrates 45 years

BRILLION - It was started in 1979 by Bob and Pat Endries to be a sister company to Endries International as a zinc plating operation. Now, 45 years later, Professional Plating is one of the leaders in its industry.

"The Endries family has been nothing but supportive and when growth makes sense, they trust the growth," General Manager Larry Dietz said.

Professional Plating Inc. (PPI) has expanded in increments. In May 1979, the barrel line was the company's sole production area. Millions of dollars of machinery has been installed and the facility itself has grown from a 10,000-square foot building to

a large footprint that included a 60,000-square foot addition in 2009 and a 65,000-square foot addition in 2015.


