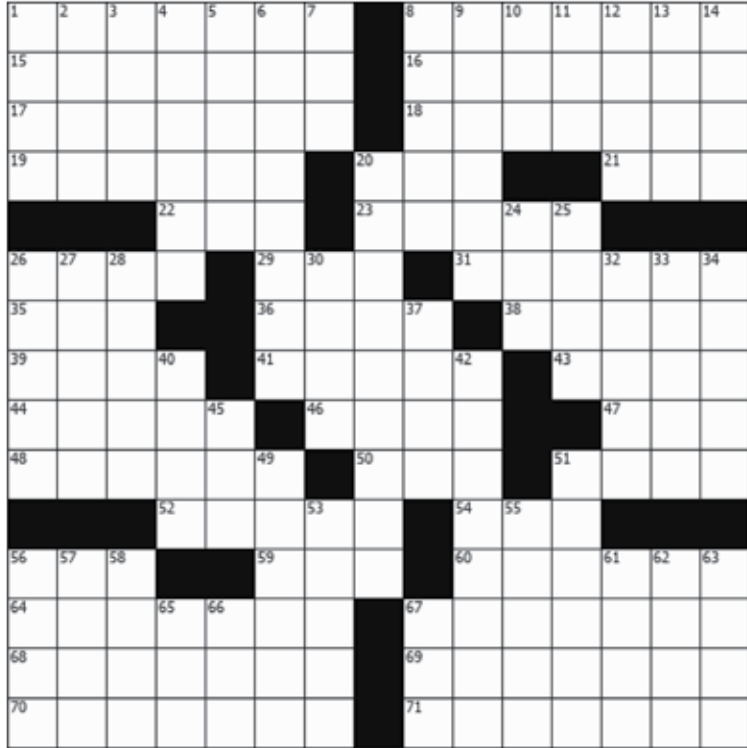

Reedsville FD fights fire at former Menchalville supper club

MENCHALVILLE – The building that used to be Reindl’s Countryside Inn, the supper club in Menchalville, was completely destroyed in a fire last Friday morning.

Sixteen members of the Reedsville Fire Department responded to the fire at the vacant restaurant near the corner of County Road K and County Road

NN at around 3:20 a.m.

The Reedsville firemen worked for close to nine hours on the call, as they arrived back to their station after 12 p.m.

The Reedsville department pages with the Menchalville department so both received the call at the same time.

“When we arrived at the scene, the flames were coming out the west side of the structure. We did try an interior attack until the conditions became unfavor-

able and we pulled crews out and we just went at it defensively,” Reedsville Fire Chief Jason Schuh said.

Once the crew was pulled out, the firefighters needed to wait for an excavator to arrive to pull the building apart.

“Once the excavator was there, we made slow work of it, just pulling it apart, trying to be as safe as we could,” Schuh said.

Once it was clear the building was a complete loss, their one job

was to put the fire out. The temperatures that were close to zero degrees in the middle of the night and into the sunrise hours didn’t help matters.

“Obviously, with the temperature, everything was turning to ice really quick so instead of doing a hurry-up operation, we did it slow and took our time,” Schuh said.

With cold temperatures like that, the water has to stay pumping once they start to avoid freez-

ing.

“A lot of times our hoses will freeze up if we don’t keep the water flowing through them so even if we’re not directing that stream at the fire itself, we have to keep that water flowing or the hoses and the nasals will freeze up which will ultimately cause the truck itself that’s pumping that water to freeze up, so we always are constantly flowing water through those lines,” Schuh said.

Brillion City Council votes against new chicken ordinance

BRILLION – Those who wished to have chickens legally at their homes within the City of Brillion had their hopes fly the coop.

City Council voted on Monday night to leave the city’s current ordinance in place which means one thing – no chickens are allowed in the city.

The unanimous vote by City Council ended a back-and-forth that lasted years on if chickens should be allowed. The Plan Commission had pushed the agenda to the Committee of the Whole after some families expressed a desire to have chickens at

their residences.

Aldersperson Kory Davis, who was the most vocal member of City Council against chickens on properties, said he does not believe citizens need to have them.

“I’m kind of on Kory’s side. I think I expressed at the last meeting that I’m not in favor of it. I may be able to be convinced with more stringent rules with regard to the setup and sign off from the neighbors. Without that, I am definitely not in favor of it,” Aldersperson Dan Farrell said during the discussion.

“I just see nothing but trouble,” Davis said, citing that his dogs were likely to go after chickens.

Hanson voices concern about center’s pool

BRILLION – Aldersperson Tim Hanson voiced concern about the health of the pool equipment at the Brillion Community Center during Monday night’s City Council meeting.

“We are one busted piece of equipment in the basement of the pool from shutting that place down because if that pool goes, there’s no reason to keep that building open anymore so that needs to be a focus,” Hanson said.

Hanson is the City Council representative on the Park and Recreation Committee. The city and committee recently

agreed to improve communication with each other once City Council voted to reinstate the committee by amending a previous vote that would have dissolved the group in April.

A central piece of those discussions, particularly a focus of Mayor Mike Smith’s, was that the community center loses money each year.

“Every day it’s open, it’s a blessing but I’m just waiting for the day that something in the basement with the pool goes and it’s not going to be [fixed],” Hanson said.

“That has happened. It flooded the basement,” Aldersperson Kory Davis said.
