

Brillion School Board says no to boundary change

BRILLION – An interesting proposal reached, and was rejected by, the Brillion School Board on Monday night.

A family who lives on Manitowoc Road in the Town of Maple Grove lives within the Brillion School District's boundaries. The family open enrolls two young children in the Reedsville School District. The family petitioned to become a part of the Reedsville district's boundaries for busing purposes.

"Essentially, we would like to just utilize the busing because we are out in the country. We like the Reedsville School District," the mother told the board prior to the vote. "We have no intention of the children coming to Brillion, regardless of what happens today or in the future."

The Brillion School Board voted unanimously against the petition to change the district's boundaries.

"Unfortunately, this comes down to revenue," Board President Brian Horn said to the woman.

The woman noted that the family's parcel of land is about 100 feet from the district's boundary line.

"We did talk to the owner of the property next to us, which consists of a field and a couple sheds. There (are) no residents there. He did however say he would also put a petition out, if need be," the woman said.

Board member Timothy Pope

said that if two parcels of land left the district, it wouldn't be as much of an "island" as one parcel

"That sets a dangerous precedent," Pope said.
Superintendent Corey

Superintendent Corey Baumgartner pointed out that would impact the tax revenues for the district further if two parcels of land were taken from the district

"If you give that away, the other residents of Maple Grove, their school portion would be larger," Baumgartner said.

Prior to the vote, Horn said he was not very interested in changing the boundary "unless you wanted to swap some land somewhere" to balance out the revenue.

"That, I've seen done,"

Baumgartner said.

The family first approached the district about the request last summer. Both districts are serviced by Kobussen Buses.

"There are times that we can give the neighboring school district to come into our boundaries. That's an agreement, if it's this particular parcel of land, we wouldn't be giving up all of the property tax portion of it for our school district, but it would allow Kobussen ... if there is an agreement," Baumgartner said.

Some board members seemed willing to look into a busing agreement between the districts but that too could have consequences.

"That can set a different precedent if everyone who wants to enroll out. Are we going to do it for

one, we do it for all," Baumgartner asked.

Baumgartner referenced a previously solved boundary issue with the Kaukauna School District.

"They were 700 feet from the line. They were right there, and we didn't want the kids walking down Highway 10. That was an isolated agreement because they were already coming here, so this could potentially fall into that," Baumgartner said.

The Brillion and Reedsville districts are already in a unique position as families in both sides of the boundary open enroll in the other.

"Even on this same road, we have a large amount of students that either have open enrolled or are currently ...

How could federal funding change for districts?

BRILLION – How could the Trump Administration's review of funding for all government departments and agencies impact schools?

Debra Phipps, the school district's business manager, presented figures to the Brillion School Board on Monday night to set the picture prior to any potential changes taking place.

Phipps noted in her report that once the Trump Administration rescinded the freeze on funding 48 hours after it was announced in late January, it was clarified that Title I and Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) for schools would not be affected. There is less clarity for other K-12 programs like Nation-

al School Lunch.

Phipps said in her report that the Brillion School District's federal funding stream "has not been compromised."

She also laid out steps to navigate potential changes including:

- Review grant agreements to understand the terms and conditions related to funding availability and reimbursement
- Identify programs supported

with federal funds and determine financial exposure if funding disruption occurs

- Have an adjustable cash flow model for different scenarios
- Work with others in your organization to evaluate options if funding is lost
- Know what sources of funding are readily available in case of disruption.

For the 2024-25 school year, the district has \$742,887 in total

federal funds through Funds 10, 27 and 50, budgeted for.

Fund 10 includes Title I (program designed to close achievement gaps), Title II (used to recruit, train and prepare candidates to become effective teachers in core academic areas), Title IV (provide student support and academic enrichment), and ESSER funds (coronavirus aid forwarded to respond to changes ...
