





Cold temps in January helped Ariens Nordic Center

BRILLION – Subzero temperatures in January meant that the workers at Ariens Nordic Center did not need to make as much snow as they did last year.

"We had to make more snow last year because we melted out so many times," General Manager Sean Becker said. "We haven't really had any measurable snow that's stayed around for an appreciable amount of time this year, but because of the cold temperatures, we were able to make what we made and keep it for a longer period of time."

At this point in 2024, Becker and his team were still making snow for events that were on the winter calendar.

"This year we didn't make as much as we did in year's past but we also shortened up our course and decided to bolster those areas that we have so that we could guarantee that we at least have a decent length course that would fit in the model or the parameters that most of the race competitions, organizing committees need to have," Becker said.

The areas that would normally have early melted spots or could have severe loss during an event warm-up have been backfilled in a few days ahead of a competition.

"I think we got luckier with the cold temps," Becker said. The snow that is at the site is tucked away strategically in 'snow farms.'

"We make it with a gun and then we just leave it right where we're making it. The nice thing about it is the top part of it will kind of crust up and it acts, if you remember the magic [shell] you used to put over your ice cream, it would harden up. Basically, that's what that acts as, a magic [shell] for snow and when it rains or if it gets warm, it just kind of sheds at the top," Becker said.

Currently there is a little less than four kilometers of the site's space filled with snow.

The cold temperatures help the site, and other businesses in Wisconsin that rely on large amounts of snow in the winter, to preserve the less amounts of snow we've had the last few years.

The site currently has about five or six inches, that have all come about one inch at a time.

Reedsville schools partner with SpEd Connect

REEDSVILLE – The Reedsville School District is now the first in the country to partner with SpEd Connect, a group that has designed an app to empower families with children in special education.

"The world of special education is very technical and difficult to understand, and I think all school districts really try to help their parents as they're going through, maybe for the first time, an evaluation process or qualifying for services [and] really trying to explain it," Superintendent Michael Nate said.

The app is designed to do just that with a place for parents to have all their child's information in one place, plus other features like its parent IEP (Individualized Education Program) manager and a behavior tracker, which helps parents navigate students' mental health and behaviors. The app also helps track necessary medication.

"It's a place for our parents to house all their documents," Nate said. "They would have that all available at their finger tips to give to outside doctors or other therapists."

The app also has a built-in directory for parents who might need anything from attorneys to

theranists

"Any resource that we can put in front of our parents and help them understand the process, the paperwork and potentially other resources, is always going to be good for us," Nate said.

Creators of the App

Christine Dodaj is the founder and president and Jillian Bichanich is the CEO of the company.

Dodaj was a parent of a student who was struggling in Greenwich, Conn., one of the wealthiest school districts in the country.

"When my daughter showed signs of struggling, they weren't

reaching out to me. I went to them, they gave me the runaround. It ended up violating all of her civil rights," Dodaj said.

Dodaj wound up suing the school district and was awarded about \$500,000. Eight other families who were in the same boat also sued with Dodaj in another discrimination lawsuit.

"The moral of the story was it didn't have to be this way. Even though we won \$15 million, none of us were lawyers or educators. We just knew the system was broken and it should have never had to be this way," Dodaj said.

During that same time, Dodaj was working on an anti-bullying software. Dodaj says bullying and special needs students are closely tied together. That was the start of the SpEd Connect app.

"I realized there was no solution for parents to organize things. When I would get together with those eight families ... we were dragging bins of paperwork together, massive binders," Dodaj said.

Dodaj had six years worth of paperwork ready for mediation for the lawsuits when she realized that "I was going to build something really great for parents."

Dodaj met Bichanich, a Wisconsin native with experience in Silicon Valley.

"When we wanted to build this company, we did not ...
