



Town of Brillion chairman unhappy with Round Lake Road

BRILLION - Town of Brillion Chairman Kevin Fischer was a guest at Monday's Brillion Committee of the Whole meeting to share concerns about the current condition of Round Lake Road.

"I asked to get on the agenda because we are very concerned about the portion of Round Lake Road that the city takes care of," Fischer said.

Fischer said the Town of Brillion, the Forest Junction Fire Department and the Potter Fire Departments will not drive on the road with any emergency equipment or town equipment until the road is fixed.

"Until it's usable again because now it's not," Fischer said.

Fischer said Brillion Public Works Supervisor Andrew Maertz notified him last week that the road will be closed due to its condition.

"It just frustrates the town quite a bit because all that traffic that's going into that concert on Thursday is going to go down our road," Fischer said, referring to the planned Jason Aldean concert at Ariens Nordic Center, which is part of the NFL's leadup to the league draft being held in Green Bay in 2025.

Approval of SRO contracts recommended to council

BRILLION - Brillion Committee of the Whole, during a special meeting on Monday night, recommended to City Council the approval of school resource officer (SRO) contracts with the Brillion and Reedsville districts for the 2024-25 school year.

The contracts, already approved by the school districts pending the city's approval at

their end, will include a 6% increase in the cost of wages from last year, as stipulated by the police union contract. Alderperson Joe Behnke had pushed for a larger increase in money paid back to the city by the schools, similar to the 35% increase the districts accepted for 2023-24. Behnke was the one person to not recommend to City Council the contracts with the 6% increase.

Initially, years ago, the districts only covered the wages to have SROs in their buildings. Last year's increase meant the districts also covered the cost of benefits. Behnke pushed for another increase this year to cover the entire cost for things like equipment and any trainings officers might take part in.

The city receives about \$70,000 between the two districts, which helps supplement the police budget. The districts pay about \$47 per hour to have the officer in their buildings. Had the increase that Behnke pushed been approved by all parties, the districts would have paid about \$58 per hour.

Much of the discussion has taken place this summer at Finance Committee meetings. A motion died on the floor at one of those meetings for the larger increase after Behnke and Joan Schmitt proposed it. Mayor Mike Smith and Alderperson Kurtis Stephany were not in support of the larger increase this year when

it was discussed at the Finance Committee level.

The history of having a police officer in both Brillion and Reedsville is lengthy and there have been many advocates for it, and discussion about it has increased greatly in the last few years. When the Brillion School Board did not renew the contract for the 2020-21 school year citing the position unnecessary because of COVID, the city approached the Reedsville School District. ...






